RARE 1953 Corvette – Sold for undisclosed amount The 1953 is considered to be one of the rarest Corvettes, with only 300 produced. Today, most are restored and are in museums or collections. This one was with the same owner in Kenosha, Wisconsin since 1967.



1965 Mustang Fastback, California Car, A code – sold for \$35,000 This beauty features a 289 4 BBL A code engine, nearly rust free body and undercarriage, and has had a long term owner since the early 1980s.



1965 Impala SS Convertible Survivor – Sold for \$24,000. This vehicle has been in storage for nearly 30 years and is a true SS. It features a 327 and automatic on the floor.



1969 Corvette Convertible – sold for \$32,000. This vehicle has been in storage for nearly 20 years and has an amazing 62,300 miles. It features a 327 and 4 speed.



1936 Ford truck – sold for \$24,000. While it is very original, aftermarket directionals were added and it has a few 1950's additions such as hydraulic brakes, 12V system, Offenhauser intake with 3 deuces and a few other small changes over the years.

We are told that only a handful survived.



1961 Mercedes 220SE 2 Door Coupe – sold for undisclosed amount. This has been garage stored since 1985 when the bodywork and paint and interior was completed and has only had one owner since new. This beauty needs to be reconditioned but has a ton of potential.



1961 Austin Healey 3000 Mk II BN7 – sold for undisclosed amount. This beauty started life in California and is a rust free example of a rare car. These models have appreciated rapidly in the last few years and it is a very fun car to drive. It has the typical Austin Healey 3000 exhaust sound and is a superb driver as it is or candidate for a Concours frame off restoration.



1970 Plymouth GTX Hemi – sold for \$86,000. This authentic 22,000 original mile survivor was rotisserie restored with no expense spared. It features the Hemi engine and Super Track Pack with Dana rear end.
